We are pleased to report that Viva Energy's contractor, Liberty, successfully and safely demolished the remaining redundant refinery stack yesterday at the Clyde (ex refinery) Terminal.

Viva Energy worked closely with Government departments, regulators and NSW emergency services to ensure the safety of employees and the community whilst the demolition activities were in progress.

We would like to thank all of our neighbours on the Camellia Peninsula for their cooperation over the course of the last few days. We appreciate that the demolition of all five stacks took a little longer than initially expected, and we appreciate the patience and support of our neighbours during this time.
