Viva Bitumen Flux

Bitumen Flux Oil

Description

Viva bitumen flux is a refined hydrocarbon used for 'fluxing' road grade bitumen to provide an intermediate term viscosity reduction to the bitumen. Typical applications include cold asphalts for pot hole repairs.

Viva Bitumen flux is **not** classified as Dangerous Goods for storage and transportation purposes by the Australian Code for the Transport of Dangerous Goods by Road and Rail.
