

**CLYDE TERMINAL CONVERSION PROJECT
DEMOLITION OF STACKS AT CLYDE
(EX REFINERY) TERMINAL**

February 2016

To our nearest neighbours,

Further to our notification on 16 February, we are pleased to report that yesterday, Viva Energy's contractor, Liberty, successfully demolished four of the five redundant refinery stacks that were part of the former Clyde Refinery. One of the stacks remains and we are now working with our demolition contractors on the safest and best method to demolish it.

The safety of employees and the community is top of mind and we continue to work with a range of Government departments, regulators and NSW police on safely demolishing the remaining stack.

The exclusion zone has primarily been lifted although it will be reinstated for short periods for any additional blasts that may need to be undertaken.

The demolition area continues to be under security surveillance and we encourage people not to take vantage points around the stack.

We expect to undertake additional blasts to demolish the remaining stack but, at this stage, we do not have a specific time for these to occur.

Some noise and vibration should be expected but only for a very short time period (30 seconds) when the blasts and expected demolition occur. Dust is expected from the demolition and it will be managed with water sprays.

Viva Energy will have numerous monitors surrounding the site and in areas to measure dust, noise and vibration from the demolition event.

We would like to thank all of our neighbours on the Camellia Peninsula for their cooperation over the course of the weekend and for their patience during any additional blasts that are required.
