

## **Community Notification Pest eradication program at Clyde Terminal, Rosehill**

To our nearest neighbours

We would like to inform you that Viva Energy will be implementing a pest eradication program in accordance with a Pest Control Order issued by the NSW EPA at its Clyde Terminal, located at Durham Street.

There is a confirmed presence of foxes (European Red Fox) species which is a declared pest species under the Local Land Services Act 2013.

The pest eradication program will involve the use of baiting with a restricted pesticide, which is strictly used in accordance with directions given in a Pest Control Order. The pesticide, known as 1080, will be placed within the fence line of the Clyde Terminal at targeted locations.

Signs informing the public about the eradication program have been placed along the fence line of the Clyde Terminal. Domestic animals, such as dogs and cats, may be affected if they enter the site.

The pest eradication program will commence on 5 December and run for five weeks (until 5 January).

The European Red Fox is not a native species to Australia; it is an introduced pest and internationally recognised as one of the most serious threats to biodiversity. We have attached a fact sheet from the Department of Primary Industries about Pest Control Orders for foxes which you may find useful.

Under the Local Land Services Act 2013, all land managers in NSW have an obligation to control declared pest species on their land.
