Viva Bitumen low flash cutter is a clear coloured refined hydrocarbon used for cutting back road grade bitumen and polymer modified binders in sprayed sealing operations. The cutter temporarily reduces the viscosity of the bitumen in the newly sprayed seal allowing the bitumen to 'wet' the cover aggregate helping to create a strong adhesive bond.

Viva Bitumen low flash cutter is classified as Dangerous Goods for storage and transportation purposes by the Australian Code for the Transport of Dangerous Goods by Road and Rail.
